**Benguet Nickel Mines Inc. (BNMI) Ushers in Holiday Season
to Sta.Cruz communities via various Donations**

The holiday season surely came early for the communities in Sta. Cruz, Zambales with the donations extended by one of the major nickel mine operators in the province, Benguet Nickel Mines Inc. (BNMI).

BNMI, a wholly-owned subsidiary of 111 year old Benguet Corporation, the country's oldest mining company, has been operating a nickel mine in the Sta. Cruz town of Zambales since 2011.

The items were duly acknowledged and received by the Punong Barangays of the two (2) Barangays. The donations will help the residents especially the school children in their daily activities.

Six (6) units of 16-inch electric stand fans were donated to the Sta. Cruz Municipal Hospital as well. Sta. Cruz Chief of Hospital Dr. Crisostomo Toralba accepted the donation saying that he is proud to be a 'Benguet boy' having served as company physician at the Masinloc Chromite operations of Benguet Corp for 2 years. The electric fans will help improve the facility and their level of service.

In another SDMP activity last October 07, BNMI AVP for Operations Engr. Glen Duka, together with the company physician Dr. Miguel Maniago, visited the Sta. Cruz Municipal Hospital again, this time bringing with them 1 unit of KVA diesel generator. Dr. Crisostomo Toralba, together with the hospital nurses, graciously accepted the donation. The chief doctor intimated that the generator will be critical in ensuring that the hospital will be able to provide quality medical care even during power outages and interruptions.

BNMI has always expressed its vision to be the partner of the Sta. Cruz communities in achieving their goals for a thriving, safe and secure way of life.
